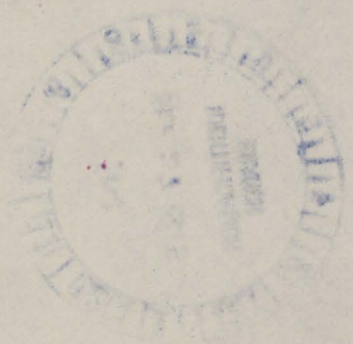

BASIS FOR DECLARING REMAINS NON-RECOVERABLE

1. According to available information, death occurred while the above listed personnel were prisoners of war at Cabanatuan POW Camp, Province of Nueva Ecija, Luzon Island, Philippine Islands. No record of burial is on file for any of the subject personnel.

2. Investigation reveals that most burials at the Cabanatuan POW Camp Cemetery were on a mass grave basis and there is no record of how the remains in any communal grave were buried. This cemetery has been disinterred and upon processing of the remains at CIP, AGRS Mausoleum, Manila, Philippine Islands, discrepancies were noted in the recording of burials, which may have been due to the fact that interment of bodies were made under war time conditions and under the supervision of the Japanese.

3. Identification data for all applicable unknowns disinterred from Cabanatuan POW Camp Cemetery have been checked against data shown on attached OQMG Forms 371 for above listed personnel with negative results.

1. The following information is from memory and is necessarily meager in that no records were maintained at that time. Records were later compiled from solicited information and are reasonably accurate. It was understood that prior to disbanding the camp an effort would be made to bury all such records. Whether this was accomplished and, if so, whether the records were recovered by the war or navy departments, I do not know.

2. I met Mr. Crotty at Camp I, Cabanatuan, P.I. about 1 June 1942, the date of our arrival at that point. We were assigned to the same barracks and I saw him every day. On a comparative basis, he was in good health until about September 1942. At that time he is believed to have contracted diphtheria. There was almost a total lack of medicines. Attending personnel were in weakened condition and the proportion of sick to the well made the amount of care that could be rendered to an individual almost negligible.

3. About three days after taking sick and, I would estimate, during the month of September 1942, Mr. Crotty died.

4. Burial procedure, at that time, was to bury ten bodies to a pit. This was necessitated by the difficulty of mustering sufficient able-bodied personnel to dig the pits and carry the litters. Officers and men were buried together but at a later date an attempt was made to mark the graves. The accuracy of the markings may not be relied upon.

5. Rites were accomplished in the following manner:

Services were held at the morgue before departure of the burial detail. If a protestant chaplain read the service at the morgue, then a Catholic chaplain accompanied the detail to the burial grounds and held at service at that point, insuring that whether protestant or catholic, they would have the services of their church. No Jewish chaplains were available.

6. By separate letter, I shall inform Mrs. Crotty of such facts as are pertinent.
