After completing the military service questionnaire and exploring home sources, also check online sources for digitized records which often contain clues. Name, rank, unit, serial/service numbers and dates of changes in unit are important clues.

The purpose of this list is to provide ideas on where to find information available in digital format.

The most popular websites for this type of information include: American Battle Monuments Commission (ABMC), Ancestry.com, FindAGrave, Fold3.com, National Archives, and Newspapers.com. This is *not* an exhaustive list of online websites or record sets. Websites change daily and it is impossible to track every change to records online.
