
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

He apparently dropped portable hand lamp, breaking the vapor glass. The open lamp coming in contact with the water in the bilge well, became shorted out. When SPOTTS attempted to retrieve lamp, he apparently received the shock that caused his death.

3. There was no indication of foul play and no evidence of negligence or inattentativeness to duty on part of officers or crew of the CAPE ISABEL. It is, therefore, recommended, that this case be closed.
