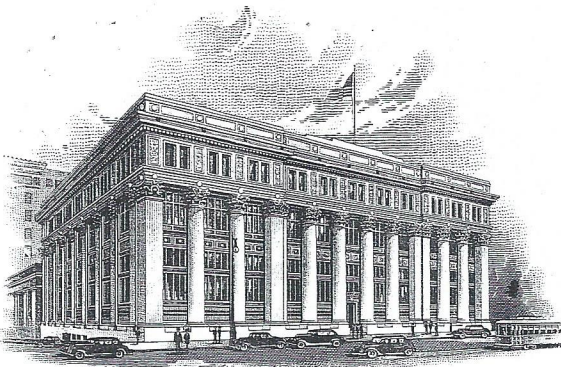
For two years she worked for me in my private law office and the third year she worked under me in the work of the one-man grand jury conducted in Detroit wherein I served as amicus curiae.
