EXTRACT FROM LAW

Sec. 1-1. Every person who served in active duty in the military or naval service of the United States at any time on or after September 16, 1940, and prior to September 3, 1945, and who, at the time of entering such service, was a resident of the State of Illinois, and ~~who~~ is honorably separated or discharged from such service, or who is still in active service, or has been retired, or has been furloughed to a reserve, and who was in such service for a period of at least sixty days, shall be entitled to receive from the Illinois Compensation Fund of the State treasury compensation of ten dollars for each month that such person was in active domestic service and fifteen dollars for each month that such person was in active foreign service during such period; provided, that any person who was in active duty in the military or naval service of the United States on September 2, 1945, may, for the purpose of qualifying for the minimum compensation under this Act, receive credit for such service thereafter but prior to November 1, 1945; provided further that the minimum compensation payable under this Act shall be fifty dollars. Compensation for a fraction of a month of service shall be paid on the basis of one-thirtieth (1/30) of the above monthly amounts for each day of such service.

No payment shall be made under this Section to any person who, though in the service, did civilian work at civilian pay; or who has received from another State a bonus or compensation of a like nature as is provided by this Act.

Service in the merchant marine shall not be considered for the purposes of this Act.

"Domestic service" means service within the Continental limits of the United States (excluding Alaska); "foreign service" means all other service.

Sec. 1-2. The husband or wife, child or children, mother, father, person standing in loco parentis, brothers and sisters, in the order named, of any deceased person shall be paid the sum or allowance that such deceased person would be entitled to under Section 1-1 of this Act, if living; but in lieu thereof, if any person died while serving in the military or naval forces of the United States on or after September 16, 1940 and prior to September 3, 1945 and his death was service-connected, his survivors as hereinbefore designated and in the order named shall be paid nine hundred dollars (\$900.00), regardless of the length of his service.

Sec. 1-3. No assignment of any right or claim to compensation under this Act shall be valid.

Sec. 1-6. All applications for compensation under this Act must be made to the Service Recognition Board before July 1, 1949 and no payments shall be made under this Act except on applications received by the Service Recognition Board before that date.

INSTRUCTIONS

The following instructions are numbered to correspond with the questions in the application. Read each one carefully before you answer the question which it covers. Use a typewriter if possible. If not, ink must be used. Fill out all the blanks. For example, if you never voted, say so. If you never paid taxes, say so. Where a question is not applicable to you because of the nature of your answer to some other question asked, say "Does not apply". Bear in mind that any error or failure to make full and complete answer to the questions will delay the payment of your claim until proper data can be secured. Remember that more than 900,000 of your comrades must be accorded consideration. Help them as well as yourself by being careful.

1. Give your name **JUST AS YOU GAVE IT WHEN YOU ENTERED THE SERVICE**. If you used your middle name then, give it now. If you used an initial then, give only an initial now. Do not give a middle name or initial now if you did not use it then. Print your name in capital letters if you do not use typewriter.

2 and 3. Self-explanatory.

4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11. If you entered the service prior to September 16, 1940, answer these questions on the basis of your residence at the time of the enlistment, induction, warrant or commission under which you were serving on September 16, 1940. For example, if you enlisted in the Regular Army January 15, 1935, and served three years, then spent a year in civil life, then enlisted again on January 15, 1939, for a three-year period, answer the questions on the basis of January 15, 1939.

12 and 13. Self-explanatory.

14. **DO NOT SEND IN YOUR REPORT OF SEPARATION OR OTHER OFFICIAL PAPERS WITH APPLICATION**. If necessary to the proper adjustment of your claim, the Board will so inform you. Attach to your application a photostatic or certified copy or copies of your "Report of Separation" copy of honorable discharge and other official record or records showing the number of years, months and days of active Domestic Service and the number of years, months and days of active Foreign Service. This must be photostat or typewritten on white paper size approximately 8½" x 11", and must contain a complete copy of all the matter appearing on both front and back of your "Report of Separation", or other official record or records of service.

Former Army men who have lost their "Report of Separation" or other official record or records, should request from The Adjutant General of the Army, Washington, D. C., a copy or a "Certificate in Lieu" thereof. Navy, Marine and Coast Guard personnel can secure similar certificates from the Bureau of Navy Personnel, Washington, D. C.

16, 17, 18, 19, 20 and 21. See instructions for questions 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11. In answering question 19, if you were in business for yourself, so state and give your business address.

22. A space is provided for a detailed account of the nature of your active service. **DOMESTIC SERVICE**--Does **NOT** include service in Alaska. **FOREIGN SERVICE**--**DOES** include service in Alaska. Complete months will be entered under heading "Months". Any fraction of a month will be shown on the basis of days under the heading "Days". See 14 above.

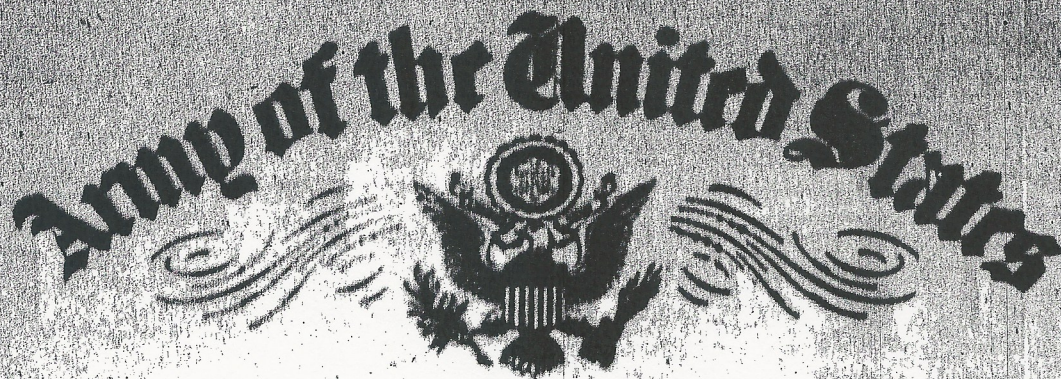
