

The Commission also will have the responsibility for permanent construction and beautification of the cemetery, including erection of the permanent headstone. The headstone will be inscribed with the name exactly as recorded above, the rank or rating where appropriate, organization, State, and date of death. Any inquiries relative to the type of headstone or the spelling of the name to be inscribed thereon, should be addressed to the American Battle Monuments Commission, Washington 25, D. C. Your letter should include the full name, rank, serial number, grave location, and name of the cemetery.

While interments are in progress, the cemetery will not be open to visitors. You may rest assured that this final interment was conducted with fitting dignity and solemnity and that the grave-site will be carefully and conscientiously maintained in perpetuity by the United States Government.

Your letter pertaining to the remains of your son, the late Private Joseph S. Kilian, has been brought to my attention.

As your letter implies that it is desired that the remains of your son be returned to the United States for final interment, but, because of the expenses incurred therein, the remains must rest in a permanent American military cemetery overseas, I wish to advise you that whenever the remains are to be transported directly to a national cemetery for final burial, the Government will complete all necessary arrangements, and be responsible for the cost of transportation, the grave site, opening of the grave, actual interment, closing of the grave, and perpetual maintenance. The Government will also provide a properly inscribed headstone. A military escort will accompany the remains to the national cemetery selected and assist, as necessary and desired, in completing arrangements for military honors at the time of burial.

In the event that you desire the remains of your son to rest in a private cemetery in the United States, the Government will assume all cost of transportation to the place designated for delivery of the remains, and will contribute a sum not to exceed \$50 toward the defrayment of actual burial expenses. Your government will, upon request by the next of kin, also provide and deliver to the railroad station nearest the cemetery an approved, properly inscribed headstone. If requested by the next of kin, the military escort will remain for the services for a period not exceeding 72 hours from the time he arrives with the remains, and will assist, as necessary and requested, in completing arrangements for desired military burial honors.

All arrangements for the burial lot, opening and closing the grave, interment, perpetual care of grave, funeral services, and military honors, if desired, are the responsibility of the next of kin. The military escort will deliver appropriate printed instructions regarding the manner of

If you should elect Option 2, it is advised that no funeral arrangements or other personal arrangements be made until you are further notified by this office.

Will you please complete the enclosed form, "Request for Disposition of Remains" and mail in the enclosed self-addressed envelope, which requires no postage, within 30 days after its receipt by you? Its prompt return will avoid unnecessary delays.

Your letter concerning your son, the late Private Joseph S. Kilian, has been received in this office.

The War Department has now been authorized to remove the remains of our honored dead, at Government expense, to the final resting place which next of kin may designate.

When the necessary verification of records has been completed, a letter with an information pamphlet and a "Request for Disposition" form attached will be mailed to you. The "Request for Disposition" form, when properly filled out, will constitute the formal expression of your detailed desires as next of kin. Until you receive these forms, therefore, it will not be necessary for you to communicate with this office regarding this subject, unless you desire to report any change of address. The necessity for complete coordination of movement in many parts of the world makes it impossible, at this time, to estimate when the mentioned forms will be mailed. Every effort, however, will be made to shorten the time between now and the date of mailing and your desires will be acted upon with a minimum of delay.

Remains will be disinterred and shipped to the place (town or city) designated by the legal next of kin at government expense. Existing regulations provide for an allowance not to exceed \$50.00 for expenses incident to interment incurred after remains arrive at the destination designated. Except in those cases where remains are shipped direct to a National Cemetery, a relative will engage the services of the receiving undertaker and be responsible for payment of his bill. Government interment allowance will be paid to the person who assumed such responsibility and instructions concerning

For this purpose a properly addressed envelope which requires no postage is inclosed. My action in forwarding these effects does not, of itself, vest legal title to them in you. I transmit these items only in order that some responsible individual receive them who is willing and able to properly distribute the same in accordance with the laws of the state in which your son lived. In some cases, the officers of certain organizations are sending funds directly to the Finance Department for deposit. On the chance that this action might have been taken, as no money belonging to your son was received at this Bureau, it is suggested that you might direct an inquiry to the Chief of Finance, Washington, D. C.

Your cooperation in effecting prompt return of the executed receipt will be very much appreciated. In closing, I wish to extend to you my deepest sympathy.


